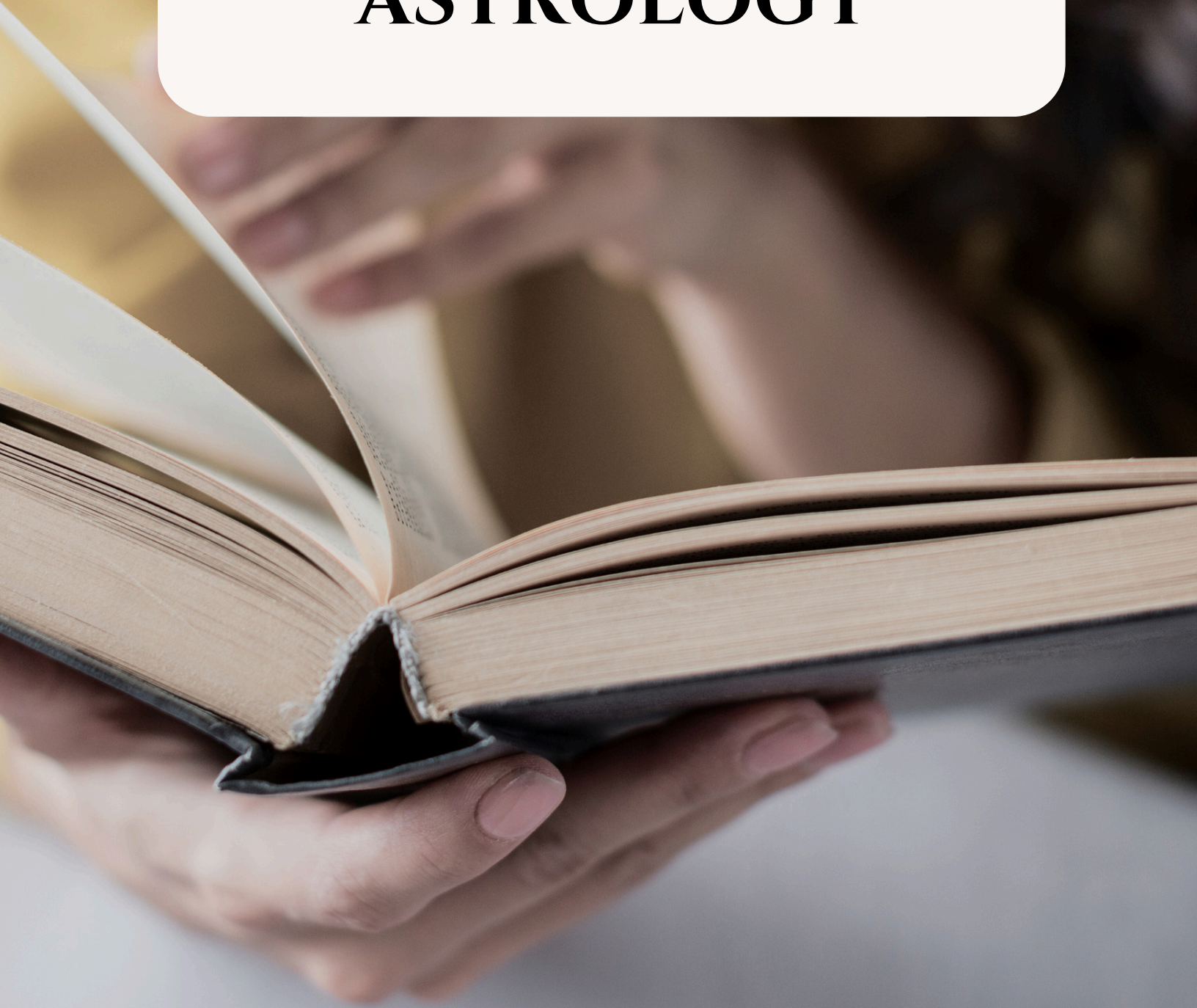

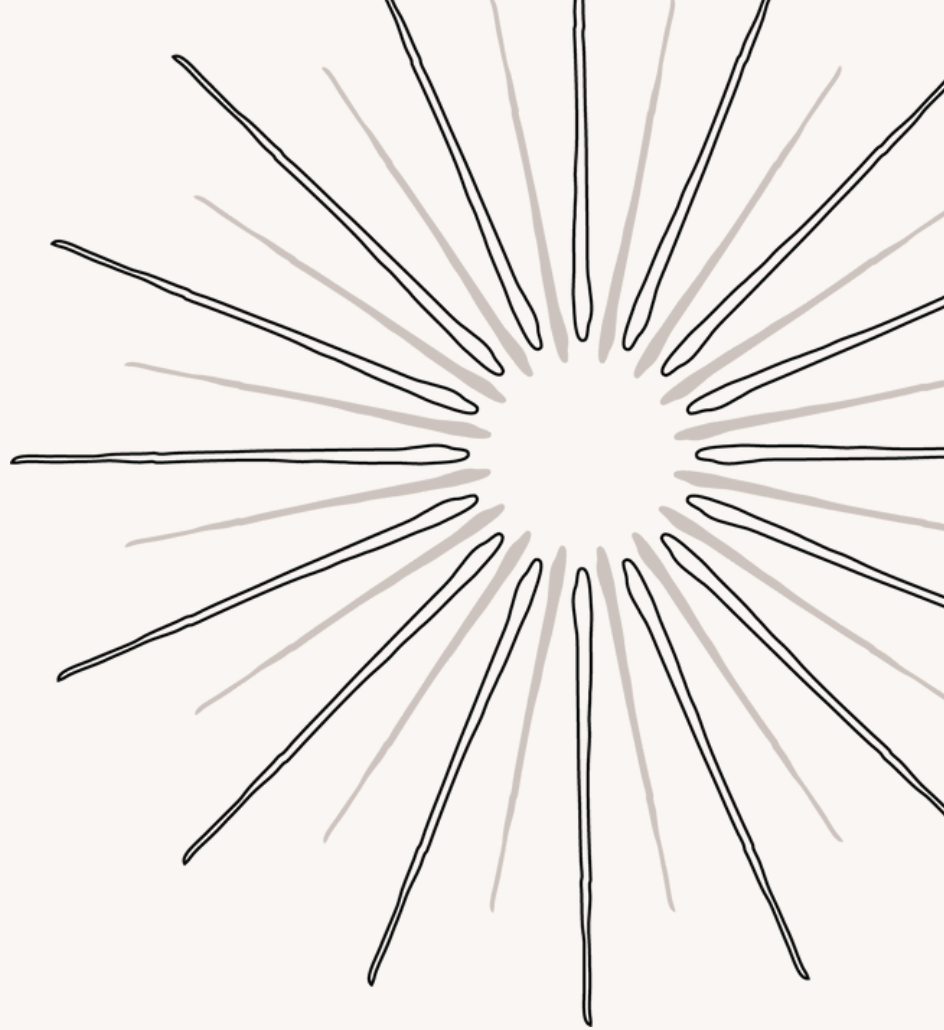

WHAT IS ASTROLOGY?

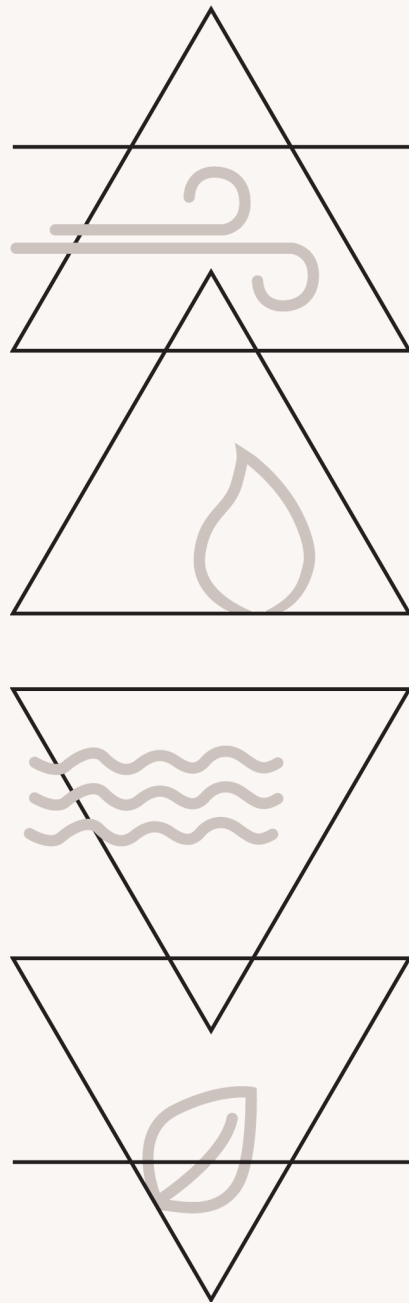

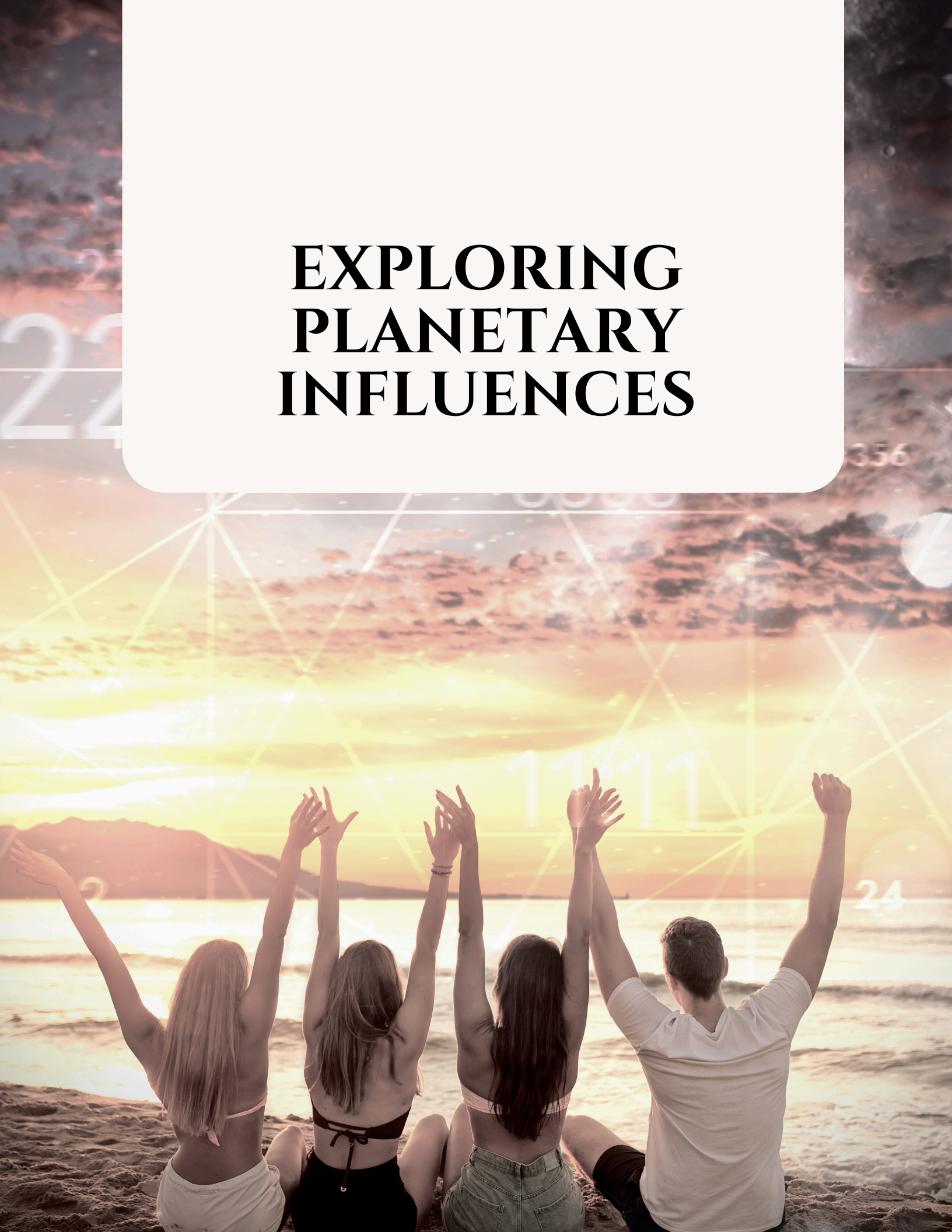
Astrologically, there are three main modes: **cardinal**, **fixed**, and **mutable**.

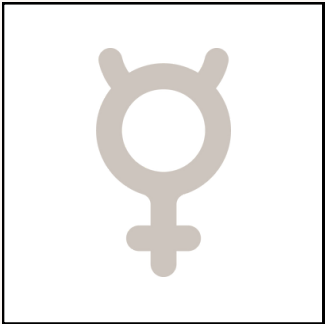
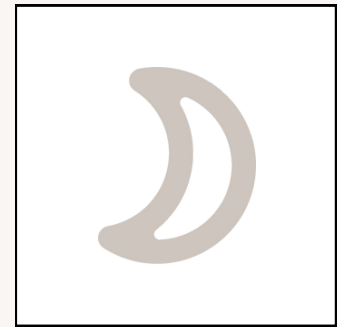


BREAK DOWN OF THE PLANETS

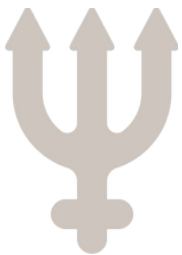

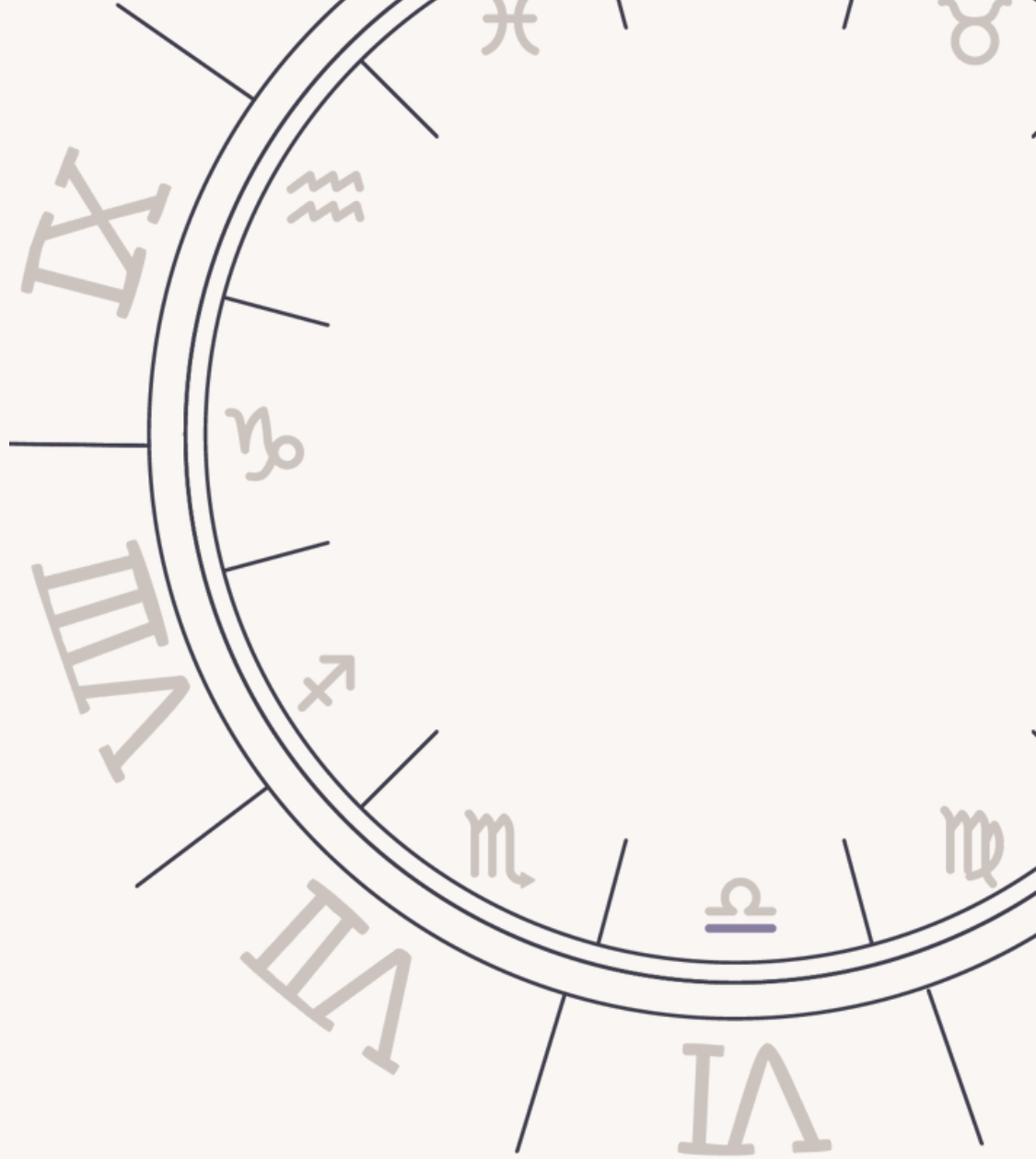

Second House: The second house governs finances, possessions, and self-worth. It represents our values, attitudes towards money, and material possessions. It influences our earning potential, financial security, and sense of self-esteem.

03

Third House: The third house governs communication, siblings, and learning. It represents our communication style, intellectual pursuits, and interactions within our immediate environment. It influences our language skills, curiosity, and relationships with siblings and neighbors.

04

Fourth House (IC): The fourth house, also known as the Imum Coeli (IC) or the Nadir, represents home, family, roots, and emotional foundations. It symbolises our sense of security, ancestral heritage, and private life. It influences our relationship with our parents, our connection to our roots, and our sense of belonging.

05

In addition to the sun, moon, and rising signs, the birth chart includes the positions of the planets at the time of your birth. Each planet represents different aspects of your personality and life experiences.

Aspects

Aspects are the angles formed between planets in the birth chart and provide valuable insights into the dynamics between different areas of life. Positive aspects, such as conjunctions and trines, indicate harmony and flow, while challenging aspects, such as squares and oppositions, may present obstacles or areas of tension.
